





DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Burgos-Gengos, Guimbal, Iloilo

10 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 June 2024 at around 5:30 PM, a flooding incident occurred at Brgy. Burgos-Gengos, Guimbal, Iloilo due to heavy rains brought about by the southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.

A total of 13 families or 53 persons sought temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. Burgos-Gengos, Guimbal, Iloilo (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,645.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by **DSWD** (see Annex C).
