19 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 June 2024, a fishing vessel traveling through the coastal waters of Brgy. Balabago, San Joaquin in Iloilo was reportedly struck by lightning at around 8:00 PM, resulting in one (1) injured fisherman.

The DSWD through its Field Office VI coordinated with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) for immediate relief assistance.
