





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Cabatuan, Palapag, Northern Samar

04 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 July 2024, an ongoing military operation of the 74th Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army in Brgy. Cabatuan, Palapag, Northern Samar restricted temporarily the residents to visit their farmlands due to the presence of armed terrorists in the area. The encounter posed threat and danger to the community causing disruption to their livelihood.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VIII, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **950 families** or **3,800 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Cabatuan, Palapag, Northern Samar** (see Annex A).
