

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao del Norte

29 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2024, heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms caused significant flooding in Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao del Norte. Said rainfall led to the overflow of Ligasawan Marsh, flooding its tributaries and waterways and affecting several families.

A total of **4,800 families** or **10,680 persons** were affected in **10 barangays** in **Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Table 1).
