

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 18-A, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental

12 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 July 2024 at around 7:15 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 5, Brgy. 18-A, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 9:00 AM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region X, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Gingoog City, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly provided relief assistance to address the urgent needs of the affected families and individuals.

Moreover, the LGU of Gingoog City, assumes the management of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) and commits to continuously provide interventions as necessary hence, the termination of this report.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **22 families** or **90 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 18-A, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **90 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **18-A Elementary School** in **Brgy. 18-A, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **17 houses** were damaged; of which, **14** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 18-A, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱891,445.44** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱204,419.00** from **DSWD** and **₱687,026.44** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
