

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Lugta, Laua-an, Antique

30 August 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 07 July 2024 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 8:00 PM, a flooding incident was experienced in Brgy. Lugta, Laua-an, Antique due to localized thunderstorms.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **56 families** or **277 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Lugta, Laua-an, Antique** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **seven (7) families** or **32 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Lugta, Laua-an, Antique** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **49 families** or **245 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex E).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **56 families** or **277 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Lugta, Laua-an, Antique** (see Annex F).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱272,976.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱269,976.00** from **DSWD** and **₱3,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
