

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 15 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 July 2024 at around 11:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Balikatan, Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **34 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **seven (7) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Rural Health Unit** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **27 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **14 families** or **34 persons** displaced in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱422,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱210,000.00** from **DSWD**, **₱194,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱18,000.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex F).
