





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

as of 15 August 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 30 July 2024 at around 11:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Balikatan, Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 14 families or 34 persons are affected in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or seven (7) persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Rural Health Unit in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are 12 families or 27 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 14 families or 34 persons displaced in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, six (6) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. San Miguel, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}422,000.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}210,000.00\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}194,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and \$\mathbb{P}18,000.00\$ from other Partners (see Annex F).
