





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon in Metro Manila

as of 28 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 28 August 2024 at 4:00 AM, the Southwest Monsoon affecting Central Luzon, Southern Luzon and Visayas may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains.

On the same day, several areas in National Capital Region (NCR) including Caloocan City, Malabon City and Valenzuela City experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by Southwest Monsoon.

A total of 51 families or 197 persons are affected in 4 barangays in Metro Manila (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **51 families** or **197 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Metro Manila** (see Annex B).
