# I. Situation Overview

On 01 August 2024 at around 2:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:58 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27 families** or **85 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **27 families** or **85 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Education Training Center School** in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **ten (10)** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion)**, **Bacolod City**, **Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱190,442.88** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
