

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental as of 01 August 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 31 July 2024 at around 3:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:48 AM.

A total of **81 families** or **241 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **81 families** or **241 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Gymnasium** in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **71 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).
