I. Situation Overview

On 07 August 2024 at around 5:26 PM, a fire incident occurred at 1642 G. Tuazon St., Brgy. 417, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:20 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **47 families** or **163 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 417** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **47 families** or **163 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10** houses were totally damaged in Brgy. **417**, Sampaloc, Manila City (see Annex C).
