

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 417, Sampaloc, Manila City as of 09 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 August 2024 at around 5:26 PM, a fire incident occurred at 1642 G. Tuazon St., Brgy. 417, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:20 PM.

A total of **47 families** or **163 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 417** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex A).
