I. Situation Overview

On 05 August 2024 at around 10:27 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 527, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:30 PM.

A total of 123 families or 428 persons are affected in Brgy. 527, Sampaloc, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are 123 families or 428 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 45 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 527, Sampaloc, Manila City (see Annex C).

08 August 2024	 DSWD FO NCR facilitated the augmentation request of Vice Mayor John Marvin C. "Yul Servo" Nieto and Senator Pia S. Cayetano for food and non-food items (FNIs) intended for the affected families. DSWD FO NCR through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) closely coordinated with the MDSW for significant updates and any requests for augmentation. DSWD FO NCR ensured the availability of FNIs.
