I. Situation Overview

On 23 August 2024 at around 7:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Batiarao, Anda, Pangasinan. The fire was declared out at around 7:15 PM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Batiarao, Anda, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Batiarao**, **Anda**, **Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱3,000.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds
