I. Situation Overview

On 19 August 2024 at around 6:56 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Buli, Muntinlupa City. The fire was declared out at around 8:00 PM.

A total of **80 families** or **231 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Buli, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex A).

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **80 families** or **231 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Brgy. Buli Covered Court** in **Brgy. Buli, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex B).

A total of **48 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Buli, Muntinlupa City** (see Annex C).
