

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cabitoonan, Toledo City, Cebu as of 13 August 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 May 2024 at around 8:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cabitoonan, Toledo City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 9:00 AM.

In response, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Toledo City, Cebu, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

**One (1) house** was totally damaged in **Brgy. Cabitoonan, Toledo City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected family (see Annex C).
