as of 28 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 August 2024 at around 10:02 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan. The fire was declared out at around 11:15 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **16 families** or **70 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **16 families** or **70 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Caloocan Sur Elementary School** in **Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, six (6) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱150,000.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
