I. Situation Overview

On 19 August 2024 at around 8:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at Calle Claro, Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City.

A total of 65 families or 254 persons are affected in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 65 families or 254 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Brgy. Camino Nuevo Covered Court in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 65 houses were damaged; of which, 62 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P87,800.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
