





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Campo Filipino, Baguio City

as of 28 August 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 27 August 2024 at around 5:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Gaerlan Street, Brgy. Campo Filipino, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 8:12 AM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the Cordillera Administrative Region together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Baguio City, promptly provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **20 families** or **38 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Campo Filipino**, **Baguio City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

## a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or seven (7) persons currently taking temporary shelter at Campo Filipino Brgy. Hall in Brgy. Campo Filipino, Baguio City (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

# c. Total Displaced Population

There are five (5) families or 18 persons displaced in Brgy. Campo Filipino, Baguio City (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Campo Filipino, Baguio City (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}485,859.20\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}287,859.20\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}198,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
