





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 15 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024 at around 12:39 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Tambo, Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 4:24 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **75 families** or **375 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Carmen**, **Cagayan de Oro City**, **Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 75 families or 375 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Carmen National High School in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱ 195,615.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex C).
