





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City

as of 06 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 5:12 AM the next day.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **61 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Fairview**, **Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) families or 11 persons currently taking temporary shelter in in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are 11 families or 50 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 14 families or 61 persons displaced in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of five (5) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}430,312.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}238,812.00\$ from DSWD; \$\mathbb{P}176,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and \$\mathbb{P}15,000.00\$ from other Partners (see Annex G).
