

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City as of 06 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 5:12 AM the next day.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **61 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **11 families** or **50 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **14 families** or **61 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱430,312.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱238,812.00** from **DSWD**; **₱176,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱15,000.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex G).
