



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City

as of 19 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 August 2024 at around 6:35 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 8:17 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **81 families** or **307 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **65 families** or **245 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Labangon Bliss Elementary School** in **Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

- b. Outside Evacuation Center There are 16 families or 42 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population There are 81 families or 287 persons displaced in Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **52** houses were damaged; of which, **46** are **totally damaged** and **6** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City** (see Annex E).
