I. Situation Overview

On 25 July 2024 at around 6:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Brgy. Labo, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 6:41 PM.

A total of two (2) families or 12 persons are affected in Brgy. Labo, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or 12 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Labo, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P55,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
