I. Situation Overview

On 22 July 2024 at around 4:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mabini, Macrohon, Southern Leyte.

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or 11 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Mabini, Macrohon, Southern Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P16,641.76** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
