

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mansaya-Lapuz, Iloilo City as of 30 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 July 2024 at around 7:35 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Mansaya-Lapuz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 8:16 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **11 families** or **32 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mansaya-Lapuz, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **11 families** or **32 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Bo. Obrero National High School** in **Brgy. Mansaya-Lapuz, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Mansaya-Lapuz, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱265,721.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱87,604.00** from **DSWD** and **₱178,117.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
