I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2024 at around 10:20 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pandan, Mambajao, Camiguin. The fire was declared out at around 11:03 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Pandan, Mambajao, Camiguin (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Pandan, Mambajao, Camiguin (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}9,817.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, \$\mathbb{P}8,317.50\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}1,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
