

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan as of 08 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 July 2024 at around 1:36 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱15,717.64** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱11,454.64** from **DSWD** and **₱4,263.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
