

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pudoc East, Tagudin, Ilocos Sur

as of 13 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 August 2024 at around 4:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pudoc East, Tagudin, Ilocos Sur.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tagudin, Ilocos Sur, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pudoc East, Tagudin, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in **Brgy. Pudoc East, Tagudin, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱18,803.20** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of **₱8,803.20** from the **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
