





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sta. Cruz, Magsaysay, Misamis Oriental

as of 28 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 August 2024 at around 3:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Purok 4, Brgy. Sta. Cruz, Magsaysay, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 3:30 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Sta. Cruz, Magsaysay, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **one** (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was are totally damaged in Brgy. Sta. Cruz, Magsaysay, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}7,216.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of \$\mathbb{P}2,216.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}5,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
