





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite

as of 09 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 August 2024 at around 1:16 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Wawa in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 3:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 585 families or 1,947 persons are affected in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 495 families or 1,641 persons currently taking temporary shelter in seven (7) evacuation centers in the City of Bacoor, Cavite (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **90 families** or **306 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 585 families or 1,947 persons displaced in the City of Bacoor, Cavite (see Annex E).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,800,410.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱1,269,600.00 from DSWD, ₱507,870.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and ₱22,940.00 from other Partners (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱608.68 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱3 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 190,693 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 56,177 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 134,516 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 98,539 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱354.49 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

09 August 2024	 DSWD FO CALABARZON in coordination with the Bacoor City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) facilitated the provision of family kits to the families affected by the fire incident.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

07 August 2024	DSWD FO CALABARZON through its Regional Quick Response
	Team (QRT) together with the LGU of Cavite conducted profiling and assessment of the affected and displaced families.

d. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
09 August 2024	 DSWD FO CALABARZON through its Emergency Operations Center (EOC) closely coordinated with the affected LGU and other concerned offices for significant updates and further augmentation requests. The EOC of DSWD FO CALABARZON was placed on alert to continuously monitor updates relative to the fire incident.
07 August 2024	 DSWD FO CALABARZON through its Regional Quick Response Team (QRT) together with the LGU of Cavite conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA).
