

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Matalam, North Cotabato

as of 16 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 30 June 2024 at 4PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 7PM, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Poblacion, Matalam, North Cotabato due to localized thunderstorms.
