



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Maindang, Lutayan, Sultan Kudarat

as of 11 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 August 2024, a flooding incident occurred in Brgy. Maindang, Lutayan, Sultan Kudarat due to heavy rainfall brought about by the localized thunderstorms. Affected families were forced to evacuate and temporarily stay in a makeshift shelter.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **87 families** or **334 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Maindang, Lutayan, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **15 families** or **57 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Maindang, Lutayan, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱40,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 184,659 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 40,143 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 144,516 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 95,453 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱341.39 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
