

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. Simsiman, Norala, South Cotabato

as of 27 August 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 23 August 2024 at around 4:20 PM, a strong wind incident was experienced in Barangay Simsiman, Norala, South Cotabato.

A total of **51 families** or **255 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Simsiman, Norala, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

**Two (2) families** or **10 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **42 houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **40** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Simsiman, Norala, South Cotabato** (see Annex C).
