

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Waterspout Incident in Taytay, Palawan as of 29 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 August 2024 at around 3:30 AM, a waterspout incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion and Beton, Taytay, Palawan, affecting families residing in coastal areas.

Issued on the same day, at 4:00 AM, the Southwest Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in MIMAROPA. Heavy rainfall accompanied by strong winds, lightning and thunder was experienced in the majority of the barangays in the municipality of Taytay.

A total of **11 families** or **54 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion and Brgy. Beton, Taytay, Palawan** (see Annex A).

There are **three (3) families** or **15 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion and Brgy. Beton, Taytay, Palawan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱9,900.00** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
