
I. Situation Overview

On 20 July 2024, Tropical Depression (TD) "Butchoy" exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 46,390 families or 139,891 persons are affected in 207 barangays in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VII, VIII and Caraga (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 1,318 families or 5,019 persons sought temporary shelter in 89 evacuation centers in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, and VII (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **10,062 families** or **38,253 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of 11,380 families or 43,272 persons were displaced in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, and VII (see Annex D).







IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 102 houses were damaged; of which, 18 are totally damaged and 84 are partially damaged in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, and VII (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱11,684,656.08 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱8,446,707.08 from DSWD and ₱3,237,949.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex F).
