





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

as of 02 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 July 2024 at around 3:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:48 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 86 families or 405 persons are affected in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 86 families or 405 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 77 houses were damaged; of which, 72 are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,059,815.84 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱690,875.84 from DSWD and ₱368,940.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
