

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental as of 02 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 July 2024 at around 3:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:48 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **86 families** or **405 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **86 families** or **405 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **77 houses** were damaged; of which, **72** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,059,815.84** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱690,875.84** from **DSWD** and **₱368,940.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
