





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Batiarao, Anda, Pangasinan

as of 06 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 August 2024 at around 7:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Batiarao, Anda, Pangasinan. The fire was declared out at around 7:15 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Anda, Pangasinan, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Batiarao, Anda, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Batiarao, Anda, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}15,692.70\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of \$\mathbb{P}12,692.70\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}3,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
