



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan

as of 02 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 August 2024 at around 10:02 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan. The fire was declared out at 11:15 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **16 families** or **70 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **16 families** or **70 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Caloocan Sur Elementary School** in **Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Caloocan Sur, Binmaley, Pangasinan** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱337,232.60 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱187,232.60 from DSWD and ₱150,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
