

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol

as of 15 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 August 2024 at around 11:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 1:20 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **88 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **47 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Covered Court** in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **seven (7) families** or **41 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **15 families** or **88 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Nocnoca, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **six (6)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱237,735.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱115,000.00** from **DSWD**, and **₱122,735.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
