

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Sapang Dalaga, Misamis Occidental

as of 06 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 August 2024 at around 8:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Poblacion, Sapang Dalaga, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 10:25 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **14 families** or **45 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Sapang Dalaga, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **14 families** or **45 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Sapang Dalaga, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **eight (8) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Sapang Dalaga, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱316,056.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱117,656.00** from **DSWD** and **₱198,400.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
