





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite

as of 17 September 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 07 August 2024 at around 1:16 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Wawa in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 3:55 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 563 families or 2,786 persons are affected in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 413 families or 1,280 persons currently taking temporary shelter in seven (7) evacuation centers in the City of Bacoor, Cavite (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **150 families** or **1,506 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 563 families or 2,786 persons displaced in the City of Bacoor, Cavite (see Annex E).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,800,410.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱1,269,600.00 from DSWD, ₱507,870.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and ₱22,940.00 from other Partners (see Annex F).
