



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Mw 6.8 Earthquake Incident in Surigao Del Sur

as of 09 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 August 2024 6:22 AM, a 6.8-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Lingig, Surigao del Sur (08.12°N, 127.16°E - 083 km N 84° E). The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **356 families** or **1,264 persons** are affected in **19 barangays** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **26 families** or **76 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **239 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **232** are **partially damaged** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Annex C).
