





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Red Tide Toxin in the Coastal Waters of Western Samar

as of 29 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 July 2024, the Department of Agriculture (DA) - Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) issued a local red tide warning for the coastal waters of the Municipalities of Jiabong, Villareal and Calbayog City, Western Samar.

According to the Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) of the affected LGUs, the effects of red tide have impacted the livelihood of the families / persons in the said areas. As of this time, no injuries or casualties related to the incident have been reported.
