



# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

as of 04 September 2024, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 31 July 2024 at around 3:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:48 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **86 families** or **405 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center There are 86 families or 405 persons sought temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **77 houses** were damaged; of which, **72** are **totally damaged** and **5** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 2 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,059,815.84 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱690,875.84 from DSWD, ₱368,940.00 from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex D).
