

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 3 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

07 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 July 2024 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 3 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:55 PM.

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 3 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,692.88** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱9,192.88** from **DSWD** and **₱1,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
