





DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pacdal, Baguio City

28 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2023 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at 035 Simsim Compound, Tiptop, Brgy. Pacdal, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 10:43 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or five (5) persons were affected in Brgy. Pacdal, Baguio City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **three (3) families** or **four (4) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Pacdal, Baguio City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}99,497.04\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}39,297.00\$ from **DSWD** and \$\mathbb{P}60,200.04\$ from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
