I. Situation Overview

On 09 July 2024 at around 4:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 10, Roxas City, Capiz. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 AM.

A total of **eight (8) families** or **11 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion 10, Roxas City, Capiz (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P55,227.52** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families and persons (see Annex D).
